Be a part of the excitement of the US National Drags. You will be working at the gates collecting or scanning tickets, stamping hands, checking coolers, and **some** individuals will be parking cars at this speedway.

This is the final parking opportunity this year and it is located at the **Lucas Oil Raceway in Clermont, Indiana**. **Students cannot work** at this speedway only individuals who are 18 years of age or older.

General Volunteer Information:

- Volunteer roles, shifts, and group assignments cannot be guaranteed.
- Volunteers are asked to work a **minimum of a four-hour shift**.
- Additional details, including shift times and roles, will be shared approximately one month prior to each event.
- **Volunteers must be 18 years of age or older**.
- All volunteers must complete the online waiver at least 48 hours prior to their shift.
- Groups are welcome to wear shirts displaying their organization's name.
- Meals are not provided. Volunteers may bring food or purchase items from on-site vendors. Bottled water will be provided.
- Most volunteer positions are outdoors and **require standing for the majority of the shift**.

At this speedway you are paid \$15 for every hour you work.

Do the math: 4 hours = \$60, 8 hours = \$120, 10 hours = \$150
