The ensemble enjoyed high marks in the Music caption and the Music General Effect caption. ISSMA rules stipulate we can't report the exact details on the scoring. However, when I say "high marks", I mean "HIGH MARKS"!

The winter percussion and guard seasons are underway. The winter

percussion ensemble boasts forty student members. That may be the largest student membership in the program's history. The show is titled "King of Thieves" and is composed by Matt Hernandez. The visual design is by Ross Werner, Creative Costuming, and Zach Schlicher.

The music for the 2024 marching show has been approved by the copyright holders. The music writers are already working on the next show. We will announce the show title and theme this spring.


